## EMAJILING A TEACHER MINIT-LESSON

This mini-lesson is a great one to kick-off the school year because it has two important objectives: students learn to craft an appropriate email to a teacher, and you get to know a bit about your students! I actually created this lesson for when I returned from my maternity leave halfway through the school year. I wanted an assignment for my first day back that would be both structured and help me to get to know my new students.

Either print the Google Doc student page as a hard-copy for each student or share it on your Google Classroom as an Assignment (select Make a Copy for Each Student). And then either go through the Google Slides on a classroom projector and have the students write/type 'notes' on the student page, or share the Google Slides presentation on your Google Classroom (select Students Can View).

Both the student page and Google Slides presentation are editable. So, be sure to change the name/details/email address to reflect your own class. You could also add more examples or take some away.





